A very important message re: parish and Father Darline's email address Robert Brown Diocesan Data Protection Lead has sent this message for us to include in our newsletter: in my capacity as Data Protection Officer for the Diocese I have become aware that several individuals who have use of a PRCDTR email account for their role are still using personal email addresses. This practice creates several problems both organisationally and for the individual which could potentially lead to legal action. Firstly, all diocesan communication needs to be secure and as such failure to use Diocesan email for Diocese and Parish work breaches that security, this in turn could nullify Diocesan insurance should a subsequent problem arise. Such use of personal email also creates a significant risk in terms of Data Protection Law. A breach of the UK General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) could result in fines running potentially into hundreds of thousands of pounds which would fall to the Diocese to pay.
