<u>The New Lectionary</u>: Starting from Advent 2024, we are required to use the "New Lectionary". The Vatican's Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of Sacraments has approved a new Lectionary proposed by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales in July of last year. The transition from the old to the New Lectionary comes with a significant cost, and both of our churches will need a set of the new edition. I am seeking generous sponsors to help cover the cost, thereby lessening the financial burden on our parish. Each set of the four volumes will cost £695, and we need two sets for both churches. Additionally, publishers will be producing People's Missals to accompany the introduction of the new Lectionary in due course.
