**450th Anniversary of St Cuthbert Mayne's Martyrdom:** On this significant anniversary, there will be an opportunity to commemorate the Patron Saint of our Diocese with a Pilgrimage in Launceston. **It will take place on Sunday, May 16th 2027.** The pilgrimage will start from 1:30 pm at Town Hall, then into Town Square for a Service at 2.30 pm, a Prayer Walk through the town, including St Mary Magdalene Church, Castle Green, Dungeon, on to the Priory, and finishing with a short service in the grounds of St Cuthbert Mayne Church at about 5.00 pm.
